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**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

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***Ordered by the state, in addition to the applicable requirements for non-critical infrastructure included in Governor Brian Kemp's executive order entitled "Reviving A Healthy Georgia", Summer Camps at CHS shall implement additional measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Such measures shall include, but are not limited to the following:***

1. *Placing signage at any entrance to instruct campers that they cannot enter if they have been diagnosed with COVID-19, have exhibited symptoms of COVID-19, or had contact with a person that has or is suspected to have COVID-19 within the past 14 days.*
  - **Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring instructional signage is adhered to prominent and high-traffic areas across campus and that all campers, camp staff, families, school employees, and campus visitors are aware of the procedures that are in place for the institution.**
2. *Placing signage at any entrance and throughout the facility to instruct campers of the enhanced sanitation procedures, social distancing requirements, and other instructions and limitations, as applicable, as set forth below.*
  - **Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring instructional signage is adhered to prominent and high-traffic areas across campus and that all campers, camp staff, families, school employees, and campus visitors are aware of the procedures that are in place for the institution.**
3. *Screening campers at drop off and preventing any camper from entering that exhibits a temperature greater than 100.4 degrees fahrenheit, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, other respiratory symptoms, or at least two of the following symptoms: chills,*

*repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.*

- **Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by screening each camper and camp staff member daily prior to allowing them to enter any school building. Anyone exhibiting the mentioned symptoms will not be allowed to enter the building and will immediately be dismissed from campus and not permitted to return for 14 days.**
- 4. *Requiring that any persons exhibiting a temperature greater than 100.4 degrees fahrenheit, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell at any time while attending a camp session shall be separated from the group immediately and must leave the camp facility as soon as practicable.*
  - **If a camper were to experience the mentioned symptoms while attending a camp session, Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by immediately sending the camper to an outdoor holding area where they will remain until the camper's parent/guardian arrives. The camper will not be permitted to return to campus for 14 days.**
- 5. *Requiring any worker or camper that has stayed home sick, been prevented from entering camp due to signs of illness, or been sent home during camp due to signs of illness shall not be permitted to attend camp again until they have either had a negative COVID-19 test or have been fever and fever medication free for 72 hours, other symptoms have improved, and at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.*
  - **Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by not permitting infected individuals to return to campus, having adhered to the mentioned guidelines and providing such documentation to the institution, until cleared to do so by the Summer Camps Coordinator.**
- 6. *Requiring parents dropping off and picking up campers to remain in their vehicles.*
  - **Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by asking for parents and guardians to remain in their vehicles at all times before, during, and after camp sessions. Camp staff will be available to escort campers from their vehicle to a designated waiting point until they are screened for entry.**
- 7. *Utilizing contactless forms of camper check in and check out.*
  - **Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by utilizing daily temperature checks by camp staff as each camper's form of check in.**
- 8. *Implementing staggered drop-off and pick-up times, with specific times for each group of campers, if practicable.*
  - **Due to the extremely limited camper capacity enforced for each camp by Christian Heritage School, along with the number of campers and camp staff members permitted in a school building throughout the entirety of each session, the institution does not deem it necessary to practice this guideline but shall do so should it be found imperative.**

9. *Providing hand sanitizer to campers as soon as practicable upon drop off.*
  - Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring hand sanitizer stations are available both at the designated drop-off location of each campus (front door entrance at High School Campus and front portico entrance at Lower and Middle School Campus), throughout the school buildings, and dispersed throughout each camp's designated meeting area.
10. *Prohibiting unnecessary visitors to camp activities and facilities.*
  - Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring unnecessary visitors are not permitted in a school building during hours in which summer camps are in session.
11. *Discontinuing camp tours.*
  - Due to the nature of Summer Camps at CHS, the institution does not deem it necessary to practice this guideline, as tours of camp are not routinely practiced.
12. *Providing training to workers on how to identify symptoms of illness in campers, the proper processes for removing a potentially ill camper, and the infection mitigation procedures to perform in such an event.*
  - Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring all camp staff members are provided with training documents to review prior to a camp's initial session, ensuring all camp staff members are completely aware of the health and safety guidelines that are in place, and, when applicable, attend a mandatory training session, scheduled by the director of each camp, on how to navigate each camp session with the guidelines that are in place.
13. *Providing an isolation area for sick workers or campers.*
  - Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by providing an outdoor holding area for each camp session where infected campers or camp staff members will remain until the camper's parent/guardian arrives or the camp staff member exits campus.
14. *To the extent necessary, limiting groups to 20 persons or less, including workers and campers, in a space where all persons gathered cannot maintain at least six feet of distance between themselves and any other person.*
  - Due to the space provided across Christian Heritage School's campus, the Director of Facilities and Campus Safety has deemed 50 as the maximum number of campers allotted in each designated area designed for each summer camp, with the exception of Art Camp (maximum number of 20 campers). Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring all persons gathered are able to maintain a distance of at least six feet between themselves and any other individual (camper or camp staff member).
15. *To the extent possible, keeping the same workers and campers in the same group for the duration of camp.*

- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring that each camp, regardless of the nature, will only allow the same camp staff workers and campers to work together for the duration of camp. This guideline will be followed differently depending upon the camp and upon the discretion of each camp director as they deem necessary and best fit for each camp's intended audience.
16. *Enforcing social distancing between groups, prohibiting gatherings, and prohibiting congregating among campers belonging to different groups.*
- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by enforcing social distancing throughout all camp sessions. Due to the nature of each camp and the contact activities involved (i.e. basketball), camp directors will ensure that the same campers work together for the duration of camp and that each group includes less than 10 campers. This guideline will be followed differently depending upon the camp and upon the discretion of each camp director as they deem necessary and best fit for each camp's intended audience.
17. *Providing a separate designated space for each camper to store personal belongings throughout the duration of the camp.*
- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring all campers have their own designated space that will be issued during the initial camp session and shall remain for the entirety of camp. Each designated space will be marked with the camper's name and will be the only area campers will be permitted to store their personal belongings throughout the duration of camp.
18. *Prohibiting use of camp facilities and equipment that are not able to be regularly sanitized.*
- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring no camp facility or equipment will be used if it is not able to be regularly sanitized.
19. *To the extent possible, allowing only one group to use camp equipment at a time.*
- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring each group uses the same camp equipment throughout all camp sessions. Camp equipment will be sanitized frequently throughout each camp session as well as at the conclusion of each camp session. Due to the nature of each camp and the contact activities involved (i.e. basketball), camp directors will ensure that the same campers work together for the duration of camp, that each group includes less than 10 campers, and that no group shares equipment in any manner. This guideline will be followed differently depending upon the camp and upon the discretion of each camp director as they deem necessary and best fit for each camp's intended audience.
20. *Sanitizing camp equipment after each group use.*

- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring camp equipment is sanitized frequently throughout each camp session as well as at the conclusion of each camp session.
21. *Requiring workers to patrol camp areas to enforce the equipment sanitization policy and conduct additional cleanings during times when equipment is not being used.*
- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring camp equipment is sanitized frequently throughout each camp session as well as at the conclusion of each camp session. Sanitization policies will be in place to ensure workers patrol camp areas and implement additional cleaning procedures during times when equipment is not being used.
22. *If swimming facilities are available, allowing each group to swim only once per day and staggering swimming times to avoid crowding at the swimming facilities.*
- Due to the nature of Summer Camps at CHS, the institution does not deem it necessary to practice this guideline, as swimming facilities are not available.
23. *If camp facilities are also open to other patrons, prohibiting contact between campers and the facility's other patrons and requiring sanitization before and after camp use of any shared facilities.*
- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring other patrons, in this instance, school faculty and staff as well as campus visitors, will not enter areas in which a camp is in session. If entrance is absolutely necessary, sanitization before and after exposure will be mandatory.
24. *Providing hand sanitizer stations for campers and requiring regular use.*
- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring hand sanitizer stations are available both at the designated drop off location of each campus (front door entrance at High School Campus and front portico entrance at Lower and Middle School Campus), throughout the school buildings, and dispersed throughout each camp's designated meeting area.
25. *Requiring campers to wash or sanitize their hands during each group restroom break, snack break, and meal break.*
- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring campers wash or sanitize their hands during each group restroom break, snack break, and throughout camp activities.
26. *For day camps, if possible, requiring campers to bring their own lunch and snacks with them to camp each day, with all such food items being in a sealed lunch bag marked with the camper's name.*
- Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by not serving school-mandated lunches or snacks throughout the duration of any camp session. Due to the nature of each camp, camp directors may allow snack breaks and will communicate to campers if they are allowed to bring their own snack.

27. *Requiring all dining facilities to follow the criteria for restaurant dine-in services herein to the extent practicable.*
- **Due to the nature of Summer Camps at CHS, the institution does not deem it necessary to practice this guideline, as dining facilities are not available.**
28. *Requiring workers to wear gloves when helping campers open items from meals and snacks.*
- **Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by requiring workers to wear gloves when helping campers open snack items.**
29. *If camp vehicles are used for transporting campers to and from on-site or off-site activities, requiring workers to sanitize each vehicle before and after use.*
- **Due to the nature of Summer Camps at CHS, the institution does not deem it necessary to practice this guideline, as transportation services will not be necessary in any manner.**
30. *Requiring workers to clean and sanitize bathrooms and all frequently touched surfaces regularly throughout the opening hours in addition to the regular cleaning schedule. Shared restrooms must be sanitized no less than twice per day.*
- **Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring all bathrooms are cleaned and sanitized by school janitorial staff, under the direction of the Director of Facilities and Campus Safety, regularly throughout the institution's opening hours in addition to the regular cleaning schedule.**
31. *Providing masks or other PPE (personal protective equipment) to workers as available and appropriate to the function and location of workers within the camp facility.*
- **Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring all camp staff workers have access to PPE throughout all camp sessions provided by the institution.**
32. *Providing masks or other PPE (personal protective equipment) to campers as available and appropriate to the activity and location of campers within the camp facility.*
- **Christian Heritage School will be adhering to this guideline by ensuring all campers have access to PPE throughout all camp sessions provided by the institution.**
33. *Overnight summer camps shall implement additional measures (...).*
- **Due to the nature of Summer Camps at CHS, the institution does not deem it necessary to practice this guideline, as no overnight summer camps will take place.**
